Regional Travel Fee



With the rising cost of travel in our region, we require students to pay a travel fee of \$60 per sport, or \$30 for Fine Arts extracurriculars, to subsidize the cost of regional travel. We are looking at other ways to reduce costs, such as bus sharing and parent drivers.

However, these measures alone will not produce the revenue needed to cover basic travel. Students athletes and Fine Arts students and families are asked to pay the fee to the main office at the start of each season.
