

- Sr Girls Basketball hosted here at CHSS, and went 1-1. Way to represent Rainmakers!




- CHSS hosted the Alumni Basketball and Winter Solstice Volleyball tournaments.





Scholarship Opportunities - Grade 12 Students

There are two upcoming scholarship opportunities, both \$5000

The B.C. Excellence scholarship is awarded to 55 high school graduates who have demonstrated service and leadership, both at school and in their communities, and who show aptitude for and commitment to their chosen career or area of post-secondary study.

We are able to nominate one student from CHSS to be considered for the B.C. Excellence Scholarship. If you are interested in being nominated, please pick up a package from the office and hand it in by **Jan. 22nd**. All applicants will be considered by the scholarship committee and the applicant chosen will be notified and nominated by the school. Final application due by Feb. 13th.

The Pathway to Teacher Education scholarship is awarded to 20 outstanding high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment to and aptitude for a career in K-12 teaching. All students interested in pursuing teacher education are welcome to apply.
